Health Alliance Medicare emphasizes prevention through comprehensive wellness coverage. We support members throughout their lives, not just through the course of a disease or medical condition.

It's smart to cover preventive services and tests, when medically appropriate, even when you are healthy. To make knowing what is covered as simple as possible, here is a partial list of the services included in your standard, comprehensive wellness benefit:

- **One wellness exam**, per member (no age limitations), per plan year when the service is billed with the primary diagnosis code for a routine general medical examination: V70.0 for adults and V20.2 for children
- **One visit to a Women's Principal Health Care Provider** per year, when the service is billed with the primary diagnosis code V72.31 for a gynecological exam (Office Visit copayment or coinsurance may apply and/or be applicable to a deductible)
- **The screenings, procedures and immunizations** listed below, within the applicable wellness benefit:
 - Blood sugar screening (including a basic metabolic panel and comprehensive metabolic panel)
 - Cervical cancer screening (Pap smear)
 - Chlamydia screening
 - Cholesterol screening
 - Colorectal cancer screening* (flexible sigmoidoscopy, screening colonoscopy, fecal occult blood test)
 - Hepatitis B vaccine
 - Influenza vaccine
 - Mammography (screening)
 - Meningococcal immunization
 - Pneumococcal vaccine
 - Prostate cancer screening



A detailed listing of covered procedures and services follows.

* Colonoscopies are covered for average-risk members age 50 and over. Colonoscopies for high-risk members are covered based on current national guidelines.

Visit our website, www.HealthAllianceMedicare.org, and log in as a member to view the most current listing of covered preventive service codes. If your doctor bills Health Alliance Medicare with a code that is not on this list, the service may not be covered under the wellness benefit.
